The summer sermon (Life Elevated) is continuing.

Financial – Dave said income (giving) for June was \$48,343 and expenses were \$61,673. This amounts to a June shortfall of \$21,305

Human Relations – Some congregation members are stating concerns about GSLC finances.

Marketing – Larry gave an estimate of around \$35,000 for a new outdoor sign.

Facilities – – John showed pictures of the cross on our building in lighter colors. It was decided that a lighter color would show up better. This is tabled until next year. The price of two new boilers is \$67,000.
