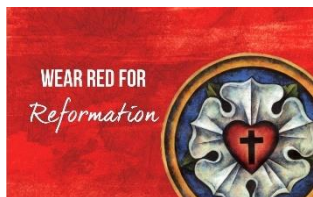

GSLC's Third Service is Returning, November 3

This service took a brief hiatus during the summer but is returning beginning November 3 at 11:00 AM.

This service is our most seeker sensitive, "come as you are," service. There are certain aspects of worship that make a liturgical



order of service: Confession and absolution, invocation, prayers for mercy, songs of praise, offering, the reading of the word, preaching, confessions of faith, and Holy Communion. All of these things still exist in the third service, but in a less structured format.

This service will be held in the Fellowship Hall, but just as with the two earlier services we need volunteers to help welcome our guests and make the service function technically. Talk to Rick to help with Audio/Visual and Barb to be an usher, greeter or pastor's assistant.



Annual Meeting/Board of Trustee Nominations

What is the Difference Between a Member and a Voting Member

With an eye towards accurate membership records at our annual meeting on November 3, we are reviewing the church database records. We have a number of people who show up as Good Shepherd Members, but not Good Shepherd "Voting" Members. In order to be a Voting Member, and for your vote to count at our Annual Meeting, the following criteria must be met in accordance with the GSLC Constitution (C5.03)

Voting Members are those Members who:

- a. are at least sixteen (16) years of age and are received or confirmed, and
- b. profess Jesus Christ as their Lord and Savior, and
- c. are baptized in the Christian faith, and
- d. attend Good Shepherd Lutheran Church regularly, and
- e. give proportionally, and
- f. appear on the Congregational Roll, and
- g. declare themselves a Member of Good Shepherd Lutheran Church

Wednesday Youth Group

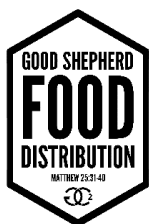

Please place your sandwiches in the middle refrigerator in the kitchen before 12:30 PM. The team picks up the fruit and sandwiches around 12:30 PM. Any fruit or sandwiches dropped off after 12:30 PM may not be delivered.

Want to help serve Sunday dinner to the homeless? You'll arrive at Catholic Community Services (437 West 200 South) at 4:30 pm and be done around 6:30 pm.
