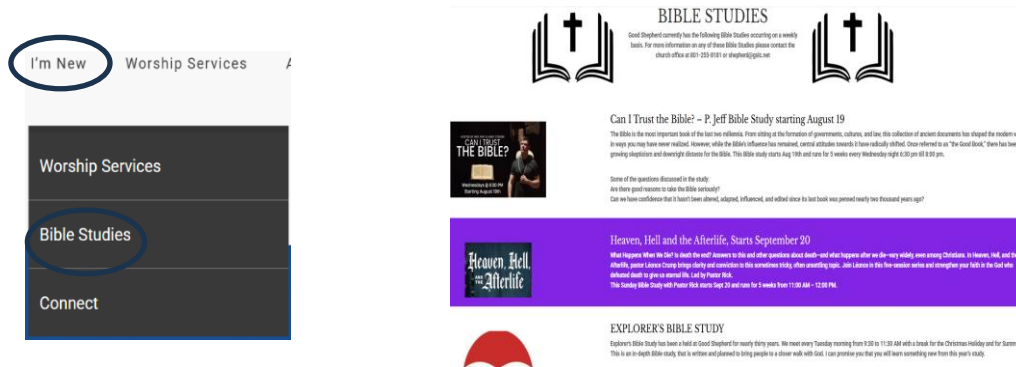
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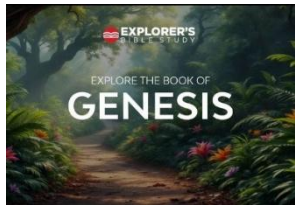


Where Can I Find Bible Studies on the Website?

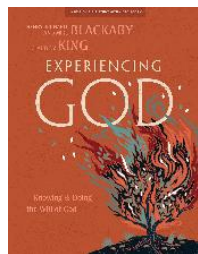
Pastor's Bible Study. Heaven, Hell and the Afterlife, Starts Sunday, September 20
